

## Terms and Conditions

Interment of Cremated Remains:

Statutory Parochial Fee (2014) - £206.00

Holy Trinity Church Fee for the provision of the plaque, and 35 letter inscription - £384.00

To Reserve a Plot - £100.00

Interment of Cremated Remains when a plot has been reserved:

Statutory Parochial Fee (2014) - £206.00

Holy Trinity Church Fee for the provision of the plaque, and 35 letter inscription – £284.00

Additional engraved letters £4.00 per letter Designs on plaques (which must be taken from the Holy Trinity Church Approved Catalogue) - £40.00

The Interment fee includes:

- Use of a single plot within the Peace Garden for one set of cremated remains;
- The granite plaque to place on the plot;
- Up to 35 letters engraved on the plaque; and
- A short service held in the Peace Garden or in Holy Trinity Church at the time of the interment of the remains.

When either an Interment is made, or a plot is reserved, the PCC would request that an annual payment of £50.00 (by Standing Order) is established to provide for the additional cost of maintenance of the Peace Garden. A single payment of £500 can be made to defray the annual payment *in perpetuity*.

At the discretion of the PCC additional set(s) of cremated remains may be interred in the same plot for which the costs are:

Statutory Parochial Fee (2014) - £206.00

Holy Trinity Church Fee for the removal, additional inscription and replacement of the plaque - £384.00

The additional Interment Fee includes:

- Use of the plot for the interment of the additional remains;
- Removal of the granite plaque to the stonemasons;
- Up to 35 additional letters engraved on the plaque;
- Replacement of the plaque on your plot; and
- A short service held in the Peace Garden or in Holy Trinity Church at the time of interment of the additional remains.

In the case of additional Interments, no additional annual maintenance payment is expected but, in the event that any fees or payments are in arrears, then such arrears must be cleared before any additional interment can take place.

There is no timed lease on the plot.

Charges will change, from time to time, as the Statutory Parochial Fee and Holy Trinity Church Fee are changed. To keep the overall appearance of the Peace Garden neat and tidy any additional items (flowers, vases etc.) that are placed on the plaque, or placed in the vicinity of the plaque, or within the Peace Garden, may be removed when maintenance takes place.
